

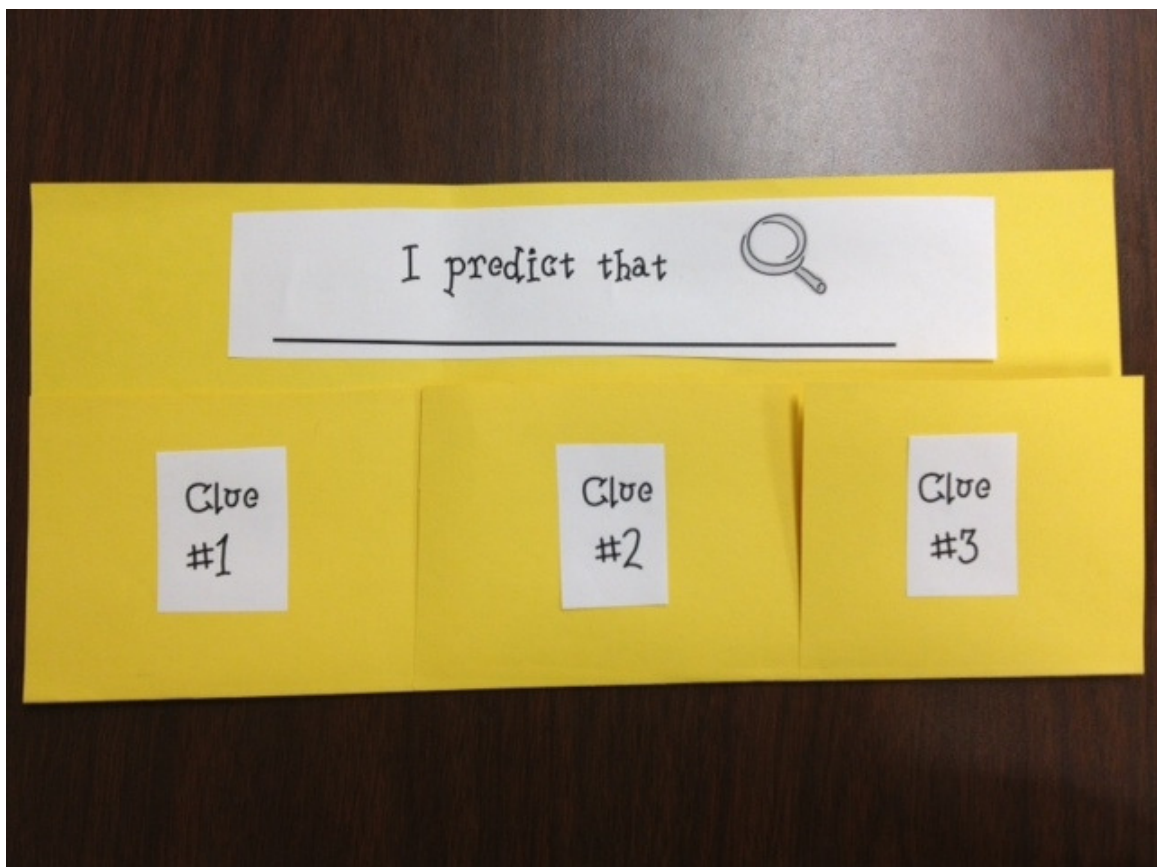
Predict & Summarize

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Predict

- Students will make a foldable to predict what they think will happen in a story.
- Show students how to assemble the foldable pictured below using an 8 1/2 x 11 sheet of paper. They will place the paper horizontally, fold up the bottom, and cut two slits.
- Show the students the cover of a book {and/ or some of the pictures from the story}
- Have students write their predictions about what will happen on the strip of paper and then glue it on the foldable
- Then, students must draw or write three clues that they used to help them make their prediction under each flap.
