

Predict


• Students will make a foldable to predict what they think will happen in a story.

• Show students how to assemble the foldable pictured below using an 81/2 * 11 sheet of paper. They will place the paper horizontally, fold up the bottom, and cut two slits.

• Show the students the cover of a book (and/ or some of the pictures from the story)

• Have students write their predictions about what will happen on the strip of paper and then glue it on the foldable

• Then, students must draw or write three clues that they used to help them make their prediction under each flap.


